

This past Thursday morning, following much discussion between me and my dad Johnny and taking into account the opinions and concerns of our bandmates, we came to the ultimate conclusion that all of BigTime's indoor shows are cancelled until further notice. We tried so hard to hold out and not make this decision but, so many shows have already been understandably cancelled by our clients and those that weren't cancelled are located in high risk areas. It has been a real struggle for us to make this decision and it was not made lightly. We know not everyone has the same opinion/concerns about Covid-19 but, we ultimately feel that it comes down to the safety of all involved... band members and attendees alike. We are not willing to risk anyone getting sick or possibly dying because of our want to perform. As my dad has said, the buck stops with us. We do have two outdoor shows still on the calendar for August which are the concert series in Sunset Beach, NC on Wednesday, Aug 5 and The Streets at Southpoint in Durham, NC on Saturday, Aug 15. We also have a Private Event that is outdoors in October. We feel these shows have stages large enough that we can be appropriately social distanced. That said, these shows happening really depends on the government and what is allowed for public gatherings. We hate to deliver this news but, the reality of our world now is that COVID-19 has changed everything from top to bottom and unfortunately, BigTime is no exception.

But, not all of our news is bad. We were recently able to get back in the studio in very small groups to do more recording on our upcoming EP. We started recording in February and hoped the CD would have been released by now. Like everything else around us, recording came to a screeching halt due to Covid-19. We will be starting the mixing process in the near future and hope to have this music out to the public soon. So, stay tuned for that.
